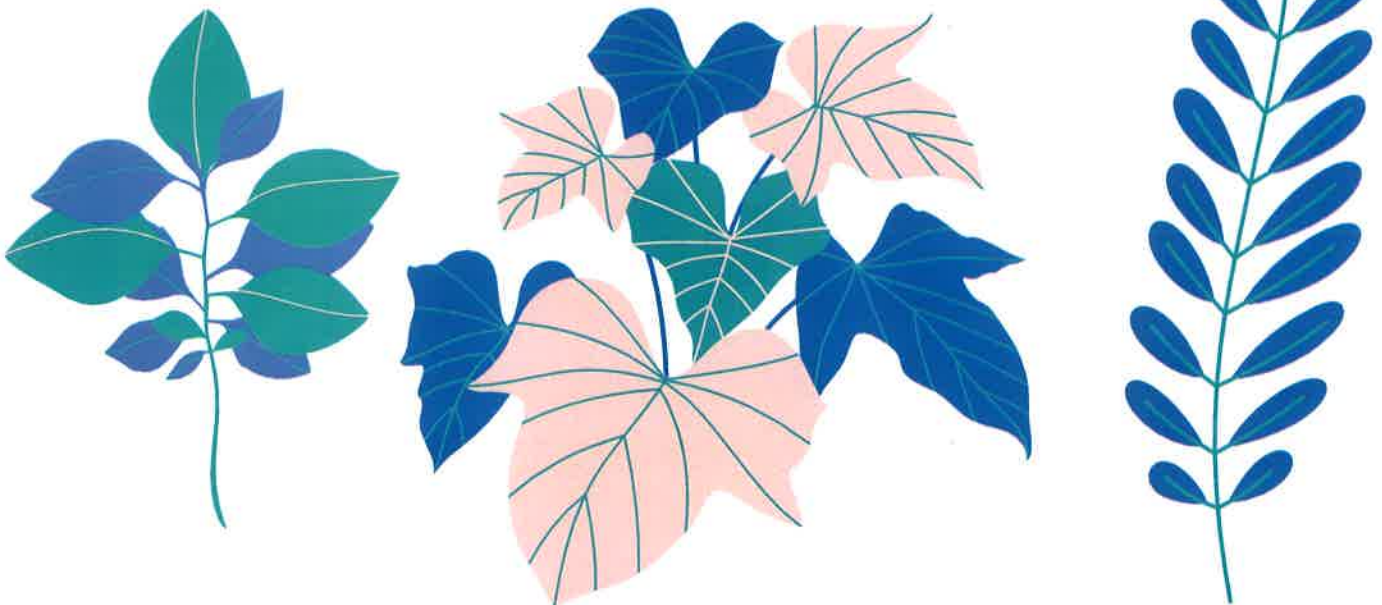
Meet the teacher!


