COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS

The following protocols will continue for the 2021-2022 school year. These guidelines are subject to change based on the recommendations given by the CDC and/or NYS Department of Health.



MASKS/FACE COVERINGS

Masks are required to be worn inside of school and on the school bus.



SOCIAL DISTANCING

CSAT will strive to maintain minimum distancing requirements of three feet (3') between individuals when inside.



HANDWASHING

Regular handwashing will be encouraged for students and staff. Time will be built into the school day to provide students additional opportunities to wash hands. Hand sanitizer will be available in all classrooms and common areas where handwashing is not an option.



SYMPTOM SCREENING

All staff and students will have their temperature taken upon arrival to school. Students and staff should stay home if they have a fever of 100.4 or higher, or have any symptoms of COVID-19.



NURSE'S OFFICE

Any student sent to the nurse's office exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms will be sent home. The nurse's office has a designated area for students who are displaying COVID-19 symptoms. Separate locations/processes will be designated for medication distribution.



WATER BOTTLES

Students are encouraged to bring a water bottle to school with them each day. Filling stations will remain in place for students to fill their water bottles throughout the day.



CLEANING + DISINFECTING

Teachers and staff will continue to use sanitizer and cleaning products, as needed, throughout the day. Desks and hard surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected every evening, in addition to the daily cleanings.

To ensure clean air

filtration, all buildings offer ventilations systems with enhanced filters which are inspected regularly and replaced monthly. Hand sanitizer will remain in classrooms and all common areas for student use throughout the day. For more information please visit the school website at
