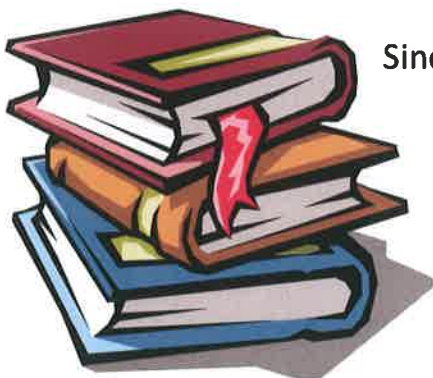
Dear Parents and Guardians,

- 1 Red college ruled spiral bound - Math

## Miscellaneous Classroom Supplies
