Seniors and Families,

We are pleased to announce that Kleinhan's Music Hall has **amended their vaccine requirement for graduation ceremonies**. In order for seniors and guests to attend the ceremony, they have the following options:

- Show **proof of vaccination for all attendees aged 5 and older**. Acceptable documentation for vaccination includes an immunization card or the New York State Excelsior pass showing at least two doses of the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines or one dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine. The ceremony date must be at least two weeks out from the date of your second dose of the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines or from your single dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine.
- Show proof of **a negative PCR test within 72 hours of the ceremony OR a negative Antigen test within 6 hours of the ceremony**.

\*Please note that an at home test will not be accepted and all attendees over the age of 13 must be prepared to show photo ID. At this time, children 2 and under are not permitted to attend events at Kleinhan's.

A formal invitation and more details will follow as the end of the year approaches. However, here are the current details we can provide:

- **Graduation will take place on Wednesday, June 22, 2022 at 7pm.**
- At this time, we can offer each graduate **five (5) tickets**. We will have some open seating in order to allow for families to social distance. Please note this is an increase from our previous limit of two, as Kleinhan's is currently operating at maximum capacity. However, the number of tickets may change as we get closer to the event based on Kleinhan's policies and the restrictions provided by the ECDOH.
- **Families will have to pay for parking at Kleinhan's.**
- All attendees, including graduates, **must wear a mask while inside Kleinhan's Music Hall.**
- In the event of a shut down or other restrictions hindering our ability to carry out the ceremony at Kleinhan's, we will plan an alternate ceremony at CHSAT.

We truly appreciate the patience and flexibility of our families as we plan this momentous event for our seniors. We will continue to send information and updates on all events throughout the school year. As always, please feel free to contact either of us with questions.
