Dear HS Parents:

We realize that remote learning is challenging on many different levels. To ensure our students' success, it is critical that we have some student/teacher interaction to sustain our remote learning program. To that end, the High School has organized an October academic intervention that will bring students into the building in small groups. The purpose of this to allow students access to their teachers, and to provide one-on-one instruction and guidance they will need to continue working from home. If successful, we will plan additional interventions in the future. *Please note that if you are uncomfortable with sending your student to school on their scheduled day, it will be a regular remote school day.*

The following safety protocols are in place to ensure the safety of all:

- Students are required to fill out a health survey.
- Temperatures will be taken upon arrival.
- Students and staff are required to wear masks while in the building.
- Students will be seated in large areas with at least 10 feet of space between desks.
 - Upstairs gym, art room, café and music room
 - No more than 13 students per room
 - Each area is equipped with their own restrooms (one student at a time).
- Upon dismissal, students must leave the premises immediately, with no congregating in the parking lot or area.

The scheduling of students will be as follows:

- Students are scheduled based on their grade level NESTS.
- No more than 4 NEST groups per session (1 NEST per room).
- Students will be with us for 2.5 hours. All students will be served breakfast when they arrive and lunch as they leave.
- There will be two sessions scheduled per day. **The AM session will run from 9 a.m to 11:30 a.m. The PM session will be from 12:30 – 3 p.m.** All areas will be sanitized between sessions.
- Students will **not** have to wear uniforms although we ask that they be appropriately dressed.
- Students **must** bring their computers, chargers, and their phones. *If students are using a non- school issued computer, one will be provided for them while they are at school.*
- Buffalo students will be given a bus pass if they need one upon arrival, however no other transportation is possible at this time.
