

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## SENIOR PORTRAITS

Students must take a formal portrait with our yearbook company Prestige Portraits. Each student was given a pre-selected date and time, found to the right, *to have their formal portrait taken at CHSAT*. ## Senior Portrait Procedures

Please read the following instructions carefully so that we can ensure everyone's safety and that the senior portraits run smoothly.

### Before Picture Day:

- Due to Covid-19 the drape and tux provided by Lifetouch for senior portraits is no longer an option. This year seniors will be responsible for the outfit that they wear for the picture. If you do not comply with the 'What to Wear & What Not to Wear' below you will be given a CSAT Polo to wear for your picture. Questions about what to wear can be directed to Mr. Latona at [jlatona@csat-k12.org](mailto:jlatona@csat-k12.org).

### What to Wear:

- **The outfit you wear must be semi-formal to formal.** Think what you would wear to a dance, graduation, wedding, or religious event. Including but not limited to dress pants, button up shirt, ties, dresses, polos, ect.
- **The outfit you wear must be majority Navy Blue, Gold, White, or Black.** Think CSAT logo colors (refer below).



### What NOT to Wear:

- Clothing with large logos or words/writing.
- Clothing with bold patterns.
- Attire which is not neat, clean and non- disruptive.
- Hats or any head covering / head gear. (Religious exemptions are permitted)
- Clothing which does not cover the chest and upper torso.
- Any apparel with rips or holes.

### The Day of Your Portrait:

- The portraits will take place in the High School gym.
- Each senior has received a designated date and time for filming, **please refer to the accompanying Senior '21 Yearbook Reminder page for the Date/Time.**
- Please arrive at least 15 minutes early to ensure you do not miss your time.

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- **You MUST be present on the date and time scheduled.** Each graduate has been allotted 15 minutes for photographing/check in. If you are late or otherwise miss your time slot, you will not be able to have your photo taken at CSAT. Unfortunately, we are under time constraints and will be unable to provide additional photography dates at CSAT. (If you cannot make your allotted time or miss your allotted time you will be directed to Lifetouch/Prestige Portraits to set up an appointment to set up a picture at their studio in Williamsville.)
- **Seniors are asked to come into their portrait session alone.** Accompanying persons will be asked to wait outside/in their car.
- As seniors arrive please enter toward the PSR/Athletic Entrance of CHSAT building.
- Seniors must wear their facemasks as they walk around/check-in but will be able to take them off during their photo.
- Once photographing is complete, seniors will be directed back to their vehicle/exit the gym through the gym doors.
- Once the process is complete, seniors must exit the parking lot/school grounds.

Other important information:

- There is a \$20 sitting fee for the senior portraits. But is only required if you would like to buy/select your portraits in the future. If you are not interested in buying or previewing/selecting your photos you don't have to pay, the seniors photo WILL be included in the yearbook/graduation either way.

It is imperative that students and families follow these procedures so that the process of photographing can run smoothly and to ensure that we are in accordance with state guidelines.
