

COVID -19 Health and Safety Protocols

(STAFF, STUDENTS and VISITORS)

Contact Tracing and Disinfection

In the case of a person testing positive for COVID-19, the Erie County Department of Health (ECDOH) will notify affected schools through the building principal/Superintendent. Should the COVID-19 Safety Coordinator/Superintendent be notified that a staff or student has tested positive for COVID-19 and not contacted by ECDOH, then ECDOH will be notified. CSAT will partner will ECDOH to ensure that all recommendations are implemented, including contact tracing and disinfection of affected areas.

Logging of Staff and Visitors

All staff (*Sonitrol*) and visitors (*Raptor*) will be logged into the electronic entry system as they enter any CSAT building and therefore their movements can be followed to a large extent. Student movements will be recorded through daily attendance and teacher narrative when necessary.

Disinfecting

All CSAT buildings are cleaned and disinfected every night. CSAT will maintain detailed logs of daily cleaning of all buildings and be ready to produce a list of disinfectants and cleaning supplies utilized by cleaning staff. Additionally, alcohol-based disinfecting solution will be available at designated dispensing stations where supervision can be maintained. Faculty and staff will be provided disinfecting supplies to spot clean high-touch areas within classrooms and offices. In areas that might be affected by a person(s)



who becomes symptomatic for COVID-19 infection, the affected area will be closed off for twenty-four (24) hours and then disinfected. For areas in which a confirmed case of COVID-19 has been reported by ECDOH to the school, CSAT will follow recommendations of ECDOH in sanitizing affected areas or dismissing school.
