

COVID -19 Health and Safety Protocols

(STAFF and STUDENTS)

Signs of Illness

All staff and students will be directed to the school health office for additional screening should they present the following signs of illness that may be related to COVID-19.

- fever or chills (100.4°F or greater),
- cough,
- shortness of breath,
- fatigue
- muscle or body aches,
- headache,
- new loss of taste or smell,
- sore throat,
- congestion or runny nose,
- nausea or vomiting and/or diarrhea

Following a health screening by the school nurse, students and staff will be sent home and directed to consult their healthcare provider for further evaluation. Testing site facilities can also be located by calling Erie County Department of Health (716) 858-2929. Students or staff showing signs of illness will be isolated in a supervised room until pick-up or drop-off can be arranged.
