Dear Seniors,

The COVID-19 emergency has evolved rapidly, leading to uncertainty as to when regular in-school classroom instruction will be able to resume throughout the state and whether students will be adequately prepared to take the Regents examinations. As a result, the Board of Regents and Department have cancelled the June 2020 administration of the NYS High School Regents Examination Program.

Students who, during the June 2020 examination period would have taken one or more Regents examinations, will be **exempted** from passing the assessments in order to be issued a diploma. To qualify for the exemption, students must meet one of the following eligibility requirements:

- The student is currently **enrolled** in a course ending in a Regents examination and has a **passing average** in that course by the end of the 2019-20 school year
- The student was previously enrolled in the course leading to an applicable Regents examination, **has achieved course credit**, and has not yet passed the associated Regents examination but intended to take the test in June 2020 to achieve a passing score.
- The student is currently enrolled in a course ending in a Regents examination and has **failing average** at the end of the school year. That student **must** return for summer school to make up the failed course and earn the course credit and is subsequently granted diploma credit in **August 2020**.

**\*\*PLEASE NOTE**

**If a student is currently enrolled in a course not ending in a Regents examination and has a **failing average** at the end of the school year, that student **must** return for summer school to make up the failed course and earn the course credit if and only if it is required to meet the 22 credits necessary to graduate. They will subsequently be granted a diploma in August 2020.**
