I will need to have a note for them to be safely dismissed. If your child is riding a bus, make sure they know the bus number. We want everyone to make it home safely, especially that first week!

4) Your child should be in proper dress code beginning on the first day of classes. You can get all your uniforms at the Family Support Center.

5) **Please make sure you send your child with all their supplies on the first day of school.** This helps with organization allows your child to be ready to learn.
